Ski Patrol Swap Equipment Guidelines

In general, the following used equipment will be accepted:

SKI, SKI BOOTS & BINDINGS

- Newer shaped alpine skis in good condition with indemnifiable bindings
- Cross country ski gear in good condition
- Newer ski boots in good condition (Only front buckle type accepted for adult boots)
- Must know boot size and gender
- Skis without bindings will only be accepted if they are not the current year model and do not have holes from prior binding mounting.

SNOWBOARD, BOOTS & BINDINGS

- Snowboard and bindings must be intact, with all parts, and in good condition
- Snowboards with or without bindings must have metal edges
- No "step-in" snowboard gear
- Snowboard boots in good condition with little wear
- Must know boot size and gender

SKI/SNOWBOARD CLOTHING & ACCESSORIES

- We accept only clean clothing that is in good condition
- Most fleece and wool fabric mid-layers are accepted
- We accept only ski/snowboard jackets and snow pants
- We will accept ski gloves, goggles, mittens, winter wear glasses, scarves, face shields, and ski face masks in good condition.
- No base layers
- No one piece jumpsuits, except spandex race suits
- No helmets
- No clothing or equipment with new tags attached
- We are not accepting any bike related or watercraft related clothing or accessories

BIKES

- The bike must be in working order
- The tires must hold air
- The brakes need to be functioning
- The drive train (chain and derailleurs) needs to function
- No cracked frames or other damage
- Any accessories need to be attached to the bike
- Bike racks (Yakima, Thule, etc...) are acceptable
- Bill of Sale to be filled out at time of equipment drop-off

WATERCRAFT

- Kayaks, canoes, SUPs, row boats and inflatables are accepted
- Must have a HIN (Hull Identification Number)
- The watercraft must float
- Inflatables must hold air
- Parts must function (keel, foot pedals, seat adjustments)
- No motors or sails; hand powered only
- Any accessories must be attached to the watercraft (paddles, pfd, covers, etc.)
- Racks are acceptable (Yakima, Thule, etc...)
- Bill of Sale to be filled out at time of equipment drop-off

SKI PATROL RETAINS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY EQUIPMENT

- Neither Boston Mills/Brandywine/Alpine Valley Ski Patrol nor Vail Resorts Management Company assumes responsibility for any lost or stolen equipment.
- We will not be responsible for the loss of items such as glasses, goggles, gloves, hats, clothing, bindings, etc. If you choose to put them in the swap, you accept their possible loss through theft.
- **Minimum price for all items is \$5.** Bikes have a minimum price requirement of \$50 and watercraft have a minimum price requirement of \$100.
- 80% of the sale price goes to YOU and 20% goes to the BMBWAV Ski Patrol, and that portion may be tax deductible.
- ALL checks for equipment sold in the swap will be mailed to the seller AFTER November 15th.
- All equipment not sold must be picked up prior to the end of sale hours on Sunday. Any leftover items will be considered a donation to the ski patrol and may be disposed of.
